



BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF PROF TY LEUNG

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Professor Tak Yeung LEUNG is the Clinical Professor of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, as well as the Director of Maternal Fetal Medicine, and Assistant Dean of the Medical Faculty of the University.

Professor Leung's research interests and professional expertise are in diagnosis and therapy of fetal abnormalities, and Obstetric emergencies. He has published more than 400 papers in international peer reviewed journals, and his current H-index is 58.

Professor Leung served in many professional organisations in the past, such as being the President of Hong Kong College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (2019-2021), editorial board member of international journals such as British Journal of Obstetrics and Gynaecology (2016-2020), member of FIGO's Preterm Working Group (2016-2019) and its panel of intrapartum fetal monitoring (2013-2017), the Chairman of the Prenatal Maternal Screening Special Interest Group of International Society for Prenatal Diagnosis (2009-2013). Besides, he had been running important annual congresses and training courses in this region, such as the Asian Pacific Congress in Maternal Fetal Medicine since 2005, Asian Pacific Congress in Fetal Therapy since 2015, and SOPHIE courses since 2014.

Because of his contribution in academic and education, Professor Leung was also awarded the Changjinag Scholar by the Ministry of Education of China in 2021, and Honorary Fellow of Hong Kong College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists in 2023.
